### STATUS REPORT

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Status Report in response to SOAH Order No. 3 and would show the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On December 31, 2015, the City of Gregory (Gregory) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to obtain new water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in San Patricio County, Texas. Gregory seeks to acquire CCNs for the area within its extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

On June 12, 2018, an Order of Referral was issued, referring the application to SOAH. On July 26, 2018, SOAH Order No. 3 was issued, memorializing the prehearing conference and directing Staff to file a status report on or before August 13, 2018. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

#### II. STATUS REPORT

Staff and Gregory have engaged in multiple discussions since July 24, 2018. Based on these discussions, it is Staff's understanding that Gregory intends to amend its application such that its requested CCN area will only include areas to which it currently provides service. In order to do this, Gregory will need to file amended maps and digital mapping data depicting its revised requested CCN area. Staff and Gregory propose the following procedural schedule for the filing and review of the application amendment:

<b>Event</b>	<b>Deadline</b>
Deadline for Gregory to file its amendment to its application	September 12, 2018
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on the amendment to Gregory's application and propose an additional procedural schedule	October 3, 2018

### **III. CONCLUSION**


Staff requests that the procedural schedule proposed above be adopted for further processing of this proceeding.


