**ORDER NO. 2**

**DEEMING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT; ADDRESSING NOTICE AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**I. Application**

On January 11, 2016, HOE Water Supply Corporation and Harris County Municipal Utility District (MUD) No. 480 filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights in Harris County.

**III. Administrative Completeness**

On February 12, 2016, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff finds that the application is sufficient for further review. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively complete.

**IV. Notice**

Commission Staff recommended that the parties provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued to the Commission. Consistent with Staff's recommendation, Applicants shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's February 12, 2016 filing, consistent with the corrections and criteria outlined in the attached memorandum of Leila Guerrero and Gary Horton, Jr. of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, and using the form attached to Commission Staff's memorandum. Applicants shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.


**V. Procedural Schedule**

The following procedural schedule is adopted:

Deadline for Applicants to file affidavits attesting to mailed and published notice, along with a copy of the notice sent	March 18, 2016
Deadline for affected persons to file a written protest, intervene, file comments, and request a hearing on the merits	Within 30 days of mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later
Deadline for Commission Staff to file an additional procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding	April 1, 2016
