Estimated occupancy method: Number of Number of Occupants for **Bedrooms Billing Purposes** The estimated occupancy for each unit is based on the 0 (Efficiency) 1 number of bedrooms as shown in the table to the 1 1.6 right. The estimated occupancy in the tenant's 2 2.8 dwelling unit is divided by the total estimated 3 4.0 occupancy in all dwelling units regardless of the actual >3 4.0 + 1.2 for each additional bedroom number of occupants or occupied units.

• Occupancy and size of rental unit percent (in which no more than 50%) of the utility bill for water/wastewater consumption is allocated using the occupancy method checked above. The remainder is allocated according to either:

• the size of the tenant's dwelling unit divided by the total size of all dwelling units, OR

• the size of the space rented by the tenant of a manufactured home divided by the size of all rental spaces.
