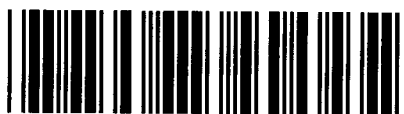

**ORDER NO. 1
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND
FILING AND SERVICE PROCEDURES**

On January 19, 2016, Friendship Cable of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications (Suddenlink or Applicant) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) under § 66.004(b) of the Public Utility Regulatory Act, Tex. Util. Code Ann. §§ 11.001-66.016 (West 2007 & Supp. 2015) for approval to amend its State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority (SICFA) No. 90023. Applicant seeks to expand its service area footprint to include the municipal boundaries of Hackberry, Texas.

A. Filing


