

This Notice addresses the application of Old Tamina Water Supply Corporation to amend water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 12289. Old Tamina requests to add a total of 190 acres to its certificated service area, 141 acres of which will be singly certificated to Old Tamina, and 49 acres of which will be dually certificated to Old Tamina and the City of Shenandoah. The Commission amends Old Tamina's CCN to include the 141-acre area for single certification and grants dual certification for the approximately 49 acres that overlap the City of Shenandoah's water service area.

I. Background

Old Tamina currently provides water service to many residents in the 540-acre community of Tamina. The City of Shenandoah's water CCN covers a portion of the Tamina community. While some residents use private wells, no sanitary sewer system is currently available to any residents in Tamina. Residents rely on private septic systems, some of which are failing, to meet their waste disposal needs. Old Tamina has proposed a plan to install sanitary sewer service in the entire Tamina community and has qualified for a loan from the United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development Administration to finance the sewer-system project. Old Tamina originally applied for both a water CCN amendment and new sewer CCN in a single application. The sewer CCN application was severed into Docket No. 45988. The amendment to Old Tamina's water CCN number 12289 will expand Old Tamina's water service area to cover the



Old Tamina Water CCN Service Area Description

Beginning at a point in the centerline of Tamina Road and David Memorial Drive an approximate distance of 6.5 feet east of the intersection of Tamina Road and David Memorial Drive.

Thence north of Tamina Road an approximate distance of 280.6 feet to David Memorial Drive.

Thence north of Tamina Road an approximate distance of 18.4 feet to a point.

Thence north an approximate distance of 178 feet to a point.

Thence east of Tamina Road an approximate distance of 196.1 feet to a point.

Thence north of Tamina Road an approximate distance of 13.9 feet to a point.

Thence east an approximate distance of 95.5 feet to a point.

Thence north of Tamina Road an approximate distance of 68.6 feet to a point.

Thence due east across Union Pacific Railroad tracks & Moore street an approximate distance of 4,080.1 feet.

Thence due south past Broadway, Simmons streets down south of Sleepy Hollow street an approximate distance of 5,015.0 feet to a point.

Thence due west of Sleepy Hollow street an approximate distance of 299.3 feet to a point.

Thence due south of Sleepy Hollow street an approximate distance of 1,181.8 feet to a point.

Thence due west past Oakridge School Road an approximate distance of 2,453.6 feet to a point.

Thence northwest above Oakridge School Road an approximate distance of 54.2 feet to a point.

Thence due west to Interstate 45 an approximate distance of 25.0 feet to a point.

Thence northwest towards Tamina Road an approximate distance of 1,790.3 feet to a point.

Thence due west to David Memorial Drive an approximate distance of 1,007.5 to a point.

Thence due north an approximate distance of 364.3 feet to Intersection of Tamina Road and David Memorial Drive.
