RE: Tariff Control No. 45565 - Application of Brazoria Telephone Company to Withdraw Services Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 26.208(h)

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

On February 1, 2016, pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 26.208(h), Brazoria Telephone Company (BTC) filed an application to withdraw certain services from its Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service Tariff. BTC proposed to discontinue Collect Calls, Bill to a Third Number, Bill to Credit Card, Line Status Verification, Busy Interrupt, and Person-to-Person services.

On February 4, 2016, this matter was docketed to allow adequate time for review. On April 4, 2016, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a recommendation to approve BTC's application. No comments or motions to intervene have been filed. Thus, the application was determined to be eligible for administrative approval and was dedocketed.



Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the request for waiver presented by BTC is granted and the following tariff sheets are approved:¹
