### MONARCH UTILITIES I, L.P.'S MOTION TO STRIKE INTERVENORS

Monarch Utilities I, L.P.'s, ("Monarch"), files this Motion to Strike Intervenors in this docket and in support respectfully shows the following;

## I. SOAH ORDER NO. 2

In SOAH Order No. 2, the Administrative Law Judges ("ALJs") outlined two specific requirements for participation in the case as an intervenor: "(1) the filing of a statement of position or testimony; and (2) participation at the settlement conference," and stated that a "mandatory settlement conference" will convene in Austin, Texas at the SOAH offices located at the William P. Clements Office Building. The conference was originally scheduled for May 24, 2016, but because of the temporary abatement of the proceeding, the settlement conference was rescheduled for August 10, 2016 by the ALJs in SOAH Order No. 4 entered on July 1, 2016.

### II. MANDATORY SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

Beginning at 10 am on Wednesday, August 10, 2016, Monarch, through its legal counsel, opened the settlement conference and noted that parties present were representatives of the Office of Public Utility Counsel ("OPUC"), Texans Against Monopolies' Excessive Rates ("TAMER"), and the Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Staff, along with Kathy Nielsen, who was participating through video-teleconference per SOAH Order No. 6. Monarch's legal counsel then proceeded to verbally call the names of all remaining intervenors. Monarch's counsel also called the name of Michael Sugrue, who filed a motion to intervene in

Attached as Exhibit "A" is a list of intervenors who have been identified by Monarch in this docket, whose names were called at the mandatory settlement conference, and who were not in attendance.

this proceeding on August 8, 2016, which has not been ruled on by the ALJs. Mr. Sugrue did not attend the mandatory settlement conference. No other intervenors identified themselves, and the parties present proceeded with the scheduled mandatory settlement conference. No other intervenors identified themselves prior to the conclusion of the settlement conference.

#### , III. PRAYER

Wherefore, premises considered, Monarch respectfully requests, per SOAH Order No. 2, that an order be entered striking all intervenors who failed to attend the mandatory settlement conference on August 10, 2016, declaring that all motions for intervention henceforth will be denied *ab initio*, and granting any other relief to which Monarch shows that it is justly entitled.
