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Comments:

1. Current Rates are exorbitant. Purchase of equipment as described is a capital expense and is depreciable over its economic life, lessening its impact
2. Water pressure: water pressure is poor and generally does not provide sufficient pressure to utilize the sprinkling system resulting in damage to landscaping items such as bushes and the grass. It also impacts bathing and showering.
3. Water quality: water quality is suspect. It is often stained to the color of iced tea or darker. While being assured that it is safe to drink and to bathe in, we are reluctant to do so.
