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My wife Debbie and I live in Henderson County in Texas where we moved after retirement fifteen years ago. In 15 years, we have seen the cost of our water go from reasonable to ridiculous. Our base bill, if we do NOT USE A DROP in one month, is around \$125.00. This is before Monarch's impending increase. Our total cost for water in 2015 was \$2,789.00 which averages out to \$232 per month. We have neighboring communities whose basic bill is one-third to one-half of what ours is. I can only conclude that the reason for this difference is because the homes in our neighborhood are upscale. IS THIS FAIR? It seems to be discriminatory to me. We use water sparingly, only watering our lawn and flowerbeds enough to keep them alive. Monarch has no competition and we have no other choice but to use them.

All I am asking is to be treated in a fair and reasonable way. When we decide to sell our home, we will have to discount it heavily in order to compensate for the cost of our water. Can you imagine what the cost of water will be in five to ten years?

Please consider this matter conscientiously and realize that a rate increase should NOT be implemented on an already exorbitant water cost. Thank you.
