To Whom it may concern:

This is regarding the rate change to the water system in Crystal Springs subdivision. After talking to persons who do not have Monarch, their water bill is anywhere from 50-75% less than ours. Some of our Houston neighbors pay approximately \$30 a month, we pay \$98 a month. And talking to my Conroe and Willis neighbors who do not have Monarch the rates are approximately \$48 a month and this is for a family of four to six and 3 different water utility companies in the immediate area. They turn it off with no notice. We can be in the shower all soaped up and all of a sudden water goes off. Some days we turn it on and there is sand in the water. And I am talking lots of sand. I don't know how many times I have had to rewash laundry because of the sand coming from the lines and caking the laundry with it. This increases my water bill because I have had to use more water. And they say they have improved the water, my foot. Their improvement has been painting the water tank so it looks new.

They just had a rate increase not too long, and now they want another one. They used this same excuse when they proposed the last rate changes.

I am very opposed to more rate changes. I believe we pay too much now.
