

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) TO PROVIDE WATER AND SEWER UTILITY SERVICE IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS

Aqua Texas, Inc., d/b/a Aqua Texas has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 13263 and 21065 for the provision of Water and Sewer utility service in Montgomery County.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 13.2 miles Southeast of downtown Conroe, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Manito Spring Rd., on the east by Laddie Hall Rd., on the south by Cypress Creek, and on the west by N. Conroe Dr.

The total proposed area being requested includes approximately 62 acres and 0.0 current customers.

Within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice, A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice. If a hearing is scheduled by the granting of the application for a CCN and (5) your proposed adjustment for application for CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no response is received and an adversary hearing is held, SOAH will issue a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If no, adversary hearing is held, it will be a hearing according similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area for "opt-out" by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date this notice was provided by the applicant. All request to opt out of the requested service area must include a sealed, general location map and a written and detailed description of the tract of land.

Persons who meet the requirements to opt out, and wish to request this option should do so in writing to the Commission.
