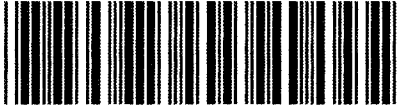

THE CITY OF GARLAND'S SUPPLEMENTAL PROOF OF NOTICE

Now comes the City of Garland (Garland) and submits supplemental proof of its compliance with the notice requirements set forth in 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 22.52(a). On February 25, 2016, Garland filed the *Application of the City of Garland to Amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for the Rusk to Panola Double-Circuit 345-kV Transmission Line in Rusk and Panola Counties*. Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.52(a), Garland provided notice of its application to all affected landowners on February 25, 2016, and filed its proof of notice on March 15, 2016.

Subsequently, Garland received returned notice packets in the mail and obtained updated addresses for several landowners from the respective county appraisal districts. Garland provided notice of its application to each landowner with an updated address by priority mail with delivery confirmation pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.52(a)(3)(E). The notice that was provided was in the same form as the notice originally provided to owners of the directly affected property; however, the notice stated that the landowner has 15 days from the date of delivery of the notice to intervene in the docket.



I, Kristi Wise, state that I am a Senior Project Manager for Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc.
