- 6 Q. DO YOU OPPOSE THE ROUTING OF THE RUSK TO PANOLA 345 KV

7 TRANSMISSION LINE BEING ON YOUR PROPERTY?

- 8 A. Yes, I do oppose he transmission line crossing my property on Segment 6
 9 for the following reasons.
- My property is located on Segment 6 (in both Southern and Central proposed routes) and was inherited from my mother. Their property has been in my family for over 100 plus years. My deceased mother told me during the 1800's; her grandfather donated the land to build a church and cemetery (my great-grandfather also preached at the church) so the community would have a place to worship. The

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historical church and cemetery is still a landmark in the community and
 borders my maternal aunt's property. Many of my family members are
 buried in that historical cemetery. There are also houses that border
 the back side of my property.

Currently, there are natural gas and oil lines on my property that have 5 been in place for years. I have been retired since 2011 and the royalty 6 income generated from the natural gas lines on the property have been 7 an immense help in augmenting my monthly income and living 8 expenses. The suggested routing 6 Segment would destroy the timber 9 that I would sell to generate income, thereby creating an adverse 10 impact on my retirement. In essence, construction of the transmission 11 line on Segment 6 could hinder oil and gas production as well as 12 financially interfere with me selling timber, potentially placing me in a 13 14 financial hardship during my retirement.

Segment 6 crosses FM 1971 and appears to be closely routed to my
 property that back up to Lake Murvaul; thus theoretically interfering
 with wildlife relative to the wetland.

The routing of Segment 6 across my land is an unfathomable
 suggestion as it would divide my property and does not parallel my
 property boundaries.

Segment 6 could pose an undue hardship to the community by
 exacerbating pre-existing conditions of the elderly and other members
 that could be adversely affected.

Segment 6 transmission line will also negatively impact any future
 capital improvements (vacation home by the lake) to the land.

3 Q. IS THERE A ROUTE YOU SUPPORT AS BEING IN ACCORDANCE 4 WITH COMMUNITY VALUES?

Yes, there was discussion of a route at a meeting held in Carthage that 5 Α. that I support. It includes Segments 1, 7, 9, 13, 23, 24, 28, 31, 34, 41, and 6 43. There were very few Intervenors that would be affected and the line 7 would be over only three habitable structures. It was also a route where 8 one of the Intervenors preferred that the line to be routed rather than two 9 other Segments where the line would cross her property. I believe most if 10 not all, the other affected Intervenors could have concerns addressed if 11 Garland attempted to do so. For instance, most people prefer the line 12 follow their property line, rather than bisect their land. 13
