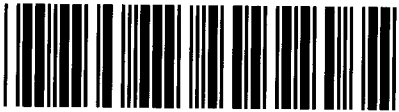

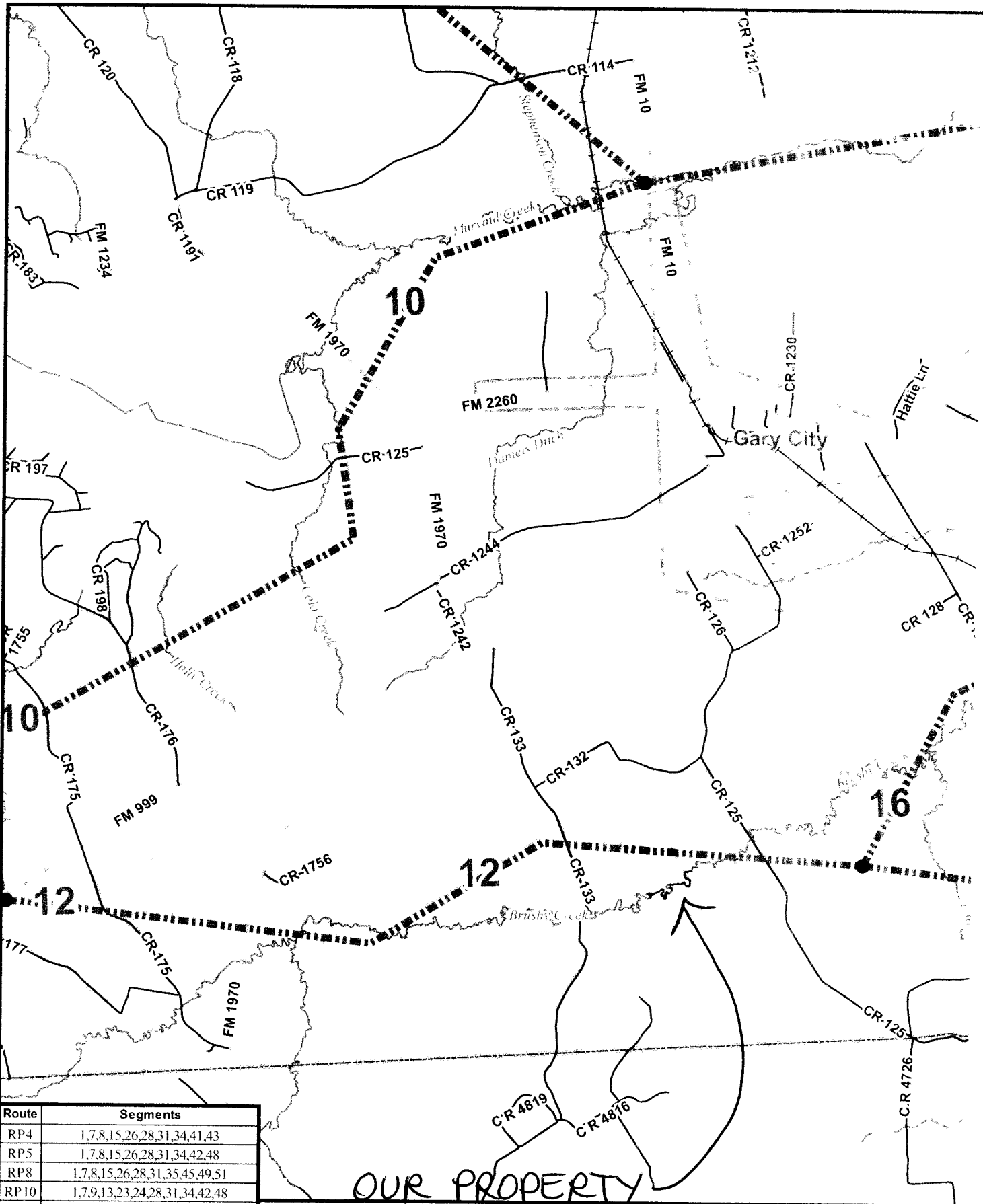

Section #12 of proposed High Voltage Power Line Route through Panola County, Tx.  
Section #12 will cut diagonally through the middle of our property (See attached map)

1. We own a 157acre award-winning pine plantation on CR 132 in Panola County that has been designated a Stewardship Forest by the Texas Forestry Service since 1989. We currently employ a Forestry Service and a forester to help with the management of our pine plantation.
2. We are currently involved in USDA-NRCS reforestation programs and have been involved with the Texas Forestry Service since 1989.
3. Proposed High Voltage Power Line Route #12 will cut diagonally through the middle of our pine plantation which will be-
  1. Financially devastating to the overall value of our property
  2. Financially devastating to our investment in our pine plantation, reforestation and timber production
  3. Significant lost revenue for the present, the near future and for the entire life of the High Voltage Power Line.
4. This High Voltage Power Line Section #12 will fragment our managed pine plantation and this fragmentation will make our pines and forest species more vulnerable to predators, parasites, competition from edge species and catastrophic events.
5. Section #12 of the High Voltage proposed route will have a significant, negative effect on the wild life which our pine plantation and forest supports, which may include, but not limited to White Tail Deer, Louisiana Black Bears, mountain lions, foxes, wolves and birds not limited to Red Woodpeckers, owls, migrating species, water fowl, dove, Peregrine Falcons and bats.
6. We have a nice 3 bedroom home on the property near the proposed Section #12 route.
7. We have a 2 ½ acre spring-fed, stocked fishing lake on the property as well as other natural springs, wetlands and Brushy Creek on the south part of our property that would be negatively affected by the Section #12 High Voltage Power Line.

8. In addition to an income-producing, award winning pine plantation, we also use our land for hunting, fishing, canoeing, and hiking and for the enjoyment of our forest and wetlands.
9. Health and environmental concerns- Electric and Magnetic Fields (EMG) /Stray Voltage /Light and noise caused by transmission lines
10. We have contacted our attorney and our forester and are in hopes we do not have to take legal action to ensure our health and safety and to protect our investments and our environment.
