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## ORDER NO. 6 REVISING STYLE OF PROCEEDING; DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application of Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua) and Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 126 (MUD 126), notice and a proposed procedural schedule. Originally, Aqua and MUD 126 filed the application for approval of a service agreement pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.248. In response to discussions with Commission Staff, Aqua and MUD 126 filed a supplemental sale, transfer, merger application in agreement that the application shall be reviewed as a sale, transfer, or merger application. Accordingly, the style of this proceeding is revised as follows: Application of Aqua Texas, Inc. and Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 126 for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and Certificate Rights in Montgomery County.

Commission Staff recommended that the application, as amended, be deemed administratively complete and that applicants be required to provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application, as amended, is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. Additionally, applicants shall provide notice consistent with Commission Staff's July 27, 2016 pleading and as specified in the attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to Commission Staff's memorandum.

The following procedural schedule shall apply:

Intervention deadline and deadline for affected persons to file a written protest, comments, and/or request a hearing on the merits	30 days after mailed or last published notice, whichever is later
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and an updated procedural schedule	Within 10 days of filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
