#### ORDER NO. 4 PROVIDING CLARIFICATION

This Order addresses Commission Staff's request for clarification in response to Order No. 3 which was issued on April 14, 2016. Commission Staff stated there are inconsistences with the proposed procedural schedule that was recommended for adoption. Specifically, the procedural schedule set an additional deadline not found in the recommended proposed procedural schedule; an August 15, 2016 deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on final disposition.

In reviewing Order No. 3, it appears that inclusion of the August 15, 2016 deadline was inadvertent. The procedural schedule is as follows:

Ninety days after the proposed effective date of the rate change is September 10, 2016, a Saturday. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin § 22.4(b), the next business day is Monday, September 12, 2016.

Deadline for Copano to respond to Staff recommendation on tariff compliance or request for a hearing; Or if not disputed issues exist, deadline for parties to file proposed findings of fact, conclusion of law, and ordering paragraphs
