**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation that the City of Cibolo's application for single certification of an area within its corporate limits and to decertify that portion of Green Valley Special Utility District's sewer certificate of convenience and necessity is deficient. Commission Staff recommended that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's April 7, 2016 pleading. Additionally, Commission Staff stated that although Cibolo notified Green Valley of its intent to provide service to the annexed area prior to filing this application as required by 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.120(b), Cibolo should be required to provide notice of this application to Green Valley and submit proof of service to the Commission.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation Cibolo's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **May 11, 2016**, Cibolo shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. In addition, Cibolo shall provide notice of this application to Green Valley as directed by Commission Staff and file proof of service on or before **May 11, 2016**. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **May 23, 2016** Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if appropriate.
