The purpose of this letter is to respond to your correspondence to Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority ("Authority") dated June 15, 2016, requesting that the Authority consent to approval by the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUC") to the application of Monarch Utilities I, L.P., to acquire the retail public water and wastewater systems of the Villas at Willowbrook Homeowners Association in northwest Harris County and amend certificates of convenience and necessity ("CCN") Nos. 12983 (water) and 20899 (sewer). The area in northwest Harris County is identified by map attached to your June 15th letter. (Copy attached.) By this letter the Authority acknowledges that it is aware that Monarch Utilities I, L.P. seeks to amend its CCNs to provide retail water and/or sewer service within the statutory boundaries of the Authority and the Authority consents to such service.

Dear Mr. Profilet,

Monarch Utilities I, LP (Monarch) has recently provided Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 191 (District 191) notice of intent to file an application with the Public Utilities Commission of Texas (PUC) to acquire the water and sewer systems serving the Villas of Willowbrook (the Villas) and amend its existing Water and Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) area to include the Villas (see Exhibit A attached).

The Villas are within the boundaries of District 191 and currently receive interim water and sewer service from District 191. The water and sewer systems serving the Villas are owned by Villas of Willowbrook Homeowners Association, Inc. Upon acquisition of the water and sewer systems, Monarch has agreed to provide retail water and sewer utility service to the Villas.

District 191 consents to the addition of the Villas to Monarch's Water and Sewer CCN and has agreed to provide Monarch wholesale water and sewer service through our contract dated December 2, 2015.
