FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; ESTABLISHING DEADLINE AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's recommendation on sufficiency filed April 11, 2016. Commission Staff recommended that the application is deficient and administratively incomplete. Commission Staff proposed the applicants be given an opportunity to address the issues as specifically described in their filing and the attached memorandum of Sean Scaff and Komal Patel of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **May 11, 2016**, applicants shall submit additional information addressing the issues outlined in the memorandum attached to Commission Staff's filing. On or before **June 10, 2016**, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application and propose a procedural.
