RE: SOAH Docket No. 473-16-3831.WS, Application of Rio Concho Aviation, Inc. for a Rate/Tariff Change, PUC Docket No. 45720

Lilo D. Pomerleau and Steven D. Arnold, the SOAH ALJs who presided over this case, are preparing a Proposal for Decision (PFD) and require the assistance of PUC Staff in order to "run the numbers." In accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.3(b)(2) and (3) and Commission policy, it is not impermissible *ex parte* communication for Commission employees who participated in the hearing to conduct number running for SOAH ALJs, provided memoranda memorializing the procedures are preserved and made available to all parties. I will act as SOAH's liaison for the number running process in this case, and SOAH will maintain copies of all memoranda generated by the ALJs and the PUC staff, and will make all such memoranda available to the parties at the time of issuance of the PFD.

As you know, the information you will be receiving during this process should be treated as the judges' work product. This means that you may not disclose the information to any other party to the proceeding but you may disclose the information to those PUC Staff members who need to know the information in order to supply SOAH with the customary schedules.

We anticipate that we will be exchanging memoranda, which may involve questions from the PUC Staff seeking clarification of the judges' decisions on specific issues. In order to avoid any inadvertent, improper communications, I will screen all memoranda coming from you before delivering them to the judges. All communication concerning this number running process from you and other PUC Staff to SOAH should be in writing and flow through you or someone designated by you to be the PUC liaison. All memoranda should be addressed to me.

The attached schedule only includes the plant items detailed in Rio Concho Ex. 2, at Attachment 3 for Schedule 1, as requested. This schedule includes items to be reconciled into the previously approved depreciation schedule, and does not represent the entire plant in service claimed by the Applicant. The ALJ's requested a deduction of \$32,465 from the applicants requested \$40,263.59 plant in service for these items. This results in \$1,345 adjusted annual depreciation (a decrease of \$6,412), and \$1,648 (a decrease of \$8,581) in accumulated depreciation for these items. The net plant for these items after the deductions is \$6,150.

These calculations only include the deductions requested, and reflects the calculations provided by the applicant for all other items on the schedule.

Response to Number Running Request 3

In calculating the rate design, I used the number of connections at the end of the test year, the amount of water billed in the test year, and the revenue requirement provided to me by Mrs. Loockerman following the adjustments requested by the ALJ. The revenue requirement was \$90,210. The methodology reflects the same fixed base rate and volumetric rate as detailed prior, which is a 73/27 percent fixed and variable design (\$66,598 and \$24,632).

Response to Number Running Request 5

There is no calculation error. The error is typographical and the \$90,210 should be \$91,210 in Staff's response to request number 3. The total revenues produced by the staff calculated rates is \$91,230. Because using the gallonage, number of connections, and split between variable and fixed expenses and rounding the gallonage rate to the penny, this is the closest the calculation can get to \$91,210 without being less than the base rate revenues (revenue requirement less other revenues). The 73/27 percent fixed and variable design (\$66,598 and \$24,632) equals revenues produced of \$91,320.
