SOAH ORDER NO. 1 DESCRIPTION OF CASE, NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE, AND GENERAL PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS

I. DESCRIPTION OF CASE

On March 22, 2016, Rio Concho Aviation, Inc. (Rio Concho) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for a rate/tariff change under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12835 in Tarrant County. Pursuant to Texas Water Code (Code) see 13.002(4-c) and 13.1872(c)(2), Rio Concho is a Class C water utility; however, it is filing its application pursuant to Code § 13.1871, which governs Class C water utilities. With regards to this rate case, the procedures applying to a Class B utilities are applicable to Rio Concho.

Commission Order No. 2 (issued by a Commission Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) on April 25, 2016) found the Application sufficient and suspended the rate change effective date for 265 days from Rio Concho's proposed effective date of April 26, 2016, until January 16, 2017.

On April 26, 2016, as recommended by Staff, in its Order of Referral the Commission referred this case to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH), requesting the assignment of a SOAH ALJ to conduct a hearing and issue a proposal for decision, if such is necessary. The Order of Referral states that Staff has requested a hearing in the case and that it appears that over 10 percent of affected ratepayers have filed a petition to appeal the rates. The order also states that the Commission will consider and possibly adopt at an open meeting currently scheduled for May 19, 2016, a preliminary order that includes a list of issues in this case and any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on threshold issues.

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The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Code §§ 13.041, 13.042, 13.1872(c(2) and 13.1871 and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.22. SOAH has jurisdiction over matters in this case relating to the conduct of the hearing and issuance of a proposal for decision, if needed, pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2003.049.

II. NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The undersigned ALJ has reviewed the protests that have been filed and found none that indicate a desire to participate in this case as a party. The ALJ concludes that no motions to intervene have been filed. A copy of this order is thus being sent only to Rio Concho and Staff.
