**ORDER NO. 5
ABATING PROCEEDING**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 28, 2016 recommendation for abatement of this proceeding. On March 25, 2016, G-M Water Supply Corporation (G-M WSC) filed an application seeking approval to acquire all of the water system assets of Frontier Park Resort & Marina (Frontier Park) held under water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 12689 in Sabine County. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality recommended that G-M WSC take over providing water services to Frontier Park customers because of Frontier Park's well system violations.

On August 29, 2016, the Commission's Oversight & Enforcement (O&E) Division filed a petition to revoke Frontier Park's CCN No. 12689.¹ The Commission has determined, that at this time, the owner, Mr. Dan Neal, holds no property capable of providing service in the certificated area and serves no customers. The CCN remains in effect but is no longer an active public water system and no other company can legally provide service in the certificated area belonging to Frontier Park.

Commission Staff recommends this docket be abated until December 1, 2016, because this docket cannot proceed until the Commission's O&E Division resolves the issues involving Frontier Park's CCN. Commission Staff stated they have communicated with G-M WSC and represents that G-M WSC agrees to such an abatement.


