On June 27, 2017, the undersigned issued SOAH Order No. 10, Granting Motions to Admit Evidence; Remand Case; and Dismissal of SOAH Docket. The order granted the parties' Joint Motion to Admit Evidence, and Proposed Order, and remanded to the Commission a fully-settled case.

Normally, a SOAH order remanding a settled case to the Commission would include a directive, usually to the applicant, to file with your office a Word version of the proposed order for your and the Commission's convenience and use.
