**ORDER NO. 2**  
**DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,**  
**ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the application and notice of City of Portland (Portland). Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively complete and that Portland provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. The City of Portland shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's April 29, 2016 filing consistent with the criteria outlined in the attached memorandum of Sean Scaff and Komal Patel of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. Portland shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted as modified to accommodate the following deadline dates. Staff shall propose an additional procedural and/or make a supplemental recommendation upon completion of notice.

Event	Date
Deadline for Applicant to provide the Commission with the Affidavits of Notice, the individual notice issued with the accompanying map, and the published notice	May 27, 2016

Deadline for affected persons to file a written protest or to intervene, deadline for affected persons to file comments, and deadline to request a hearing on the merits	30 days after mailed or last published notice, whichever is later
Deadline for Commission Staff to file an updated procedural schedule	June 10, 2016
