**Dear Public Utility Commission of Texas,**

**We are greatly concerned and disappointed in the current decision to run the transmission lines in the proposed path. We are a family with two young kids who own a home in Vista Oaks which pretty much butts right up to County Rd. 175. The current proposed path would greatly affect our lives as it would go almost directly over our heads. We purchased a home in this neighborhood for many reasons. First of all, the neighborhood is very beautiful and kept up well by the residents. Secondly, was its extremely close proximity to the Williamson County Regional Park. Knowing we would be raising kids in this neighborhood we wanted a beautiful, natural and peaceful park close by which we could enjoy as a family whether it was taking walks, bike riding or just exploring around the park. We regularly spend time there as a family and are very upset and saddened knowing transmission lines may be directly over-head in the near future. An even greater concern for my family is the huge safety risk having them almost over our house or even close by. Electricity and fires kill people and I can't fathom the thought of an accident injuring my family or neighbors. We are also extremely concerned about the health risks of living so close to power lines. My 2 yr. old son will be attending Westside Christian Pre-school(1431) starting this fall and my 5yr old daughter will be attending Parkside Elementary(Cnty Rd. 175). We are extremely concerned for the safety of our children and others attending these schools. Lastly, is our huge concern over the property values plunging in our neighborhood. We purchased this house in hopes of it being an investment for the future for our family. Losing our property value due to transmission lines financially hurts our family long-term. Please reconsider the current path proposed and take the route with least impact on our community. Think about all the lives you are affecting and more importantly the safety in this decision. Ask yourself, how would you feel if your house and family were being directly affected by this decision? Thank you for your time and I hope you all do the humane thing for your fellow members of the community we all love.**
