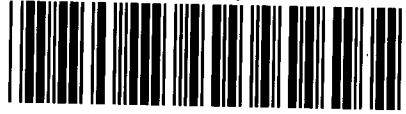

**SOAH ORDER NO. 12
DENYING MOTION TO SET HEARING
AND GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

The schedule in this case was previously continued, as requested by the parties. When a revised schedule was not proposed, Order No. 13 ordered the parties to provide one by March 14, 2017. On that day, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) filed a motion to reset the hearing on September 26-27, 2017. Staff's motion had been agreed to by all parties except the City of Frisco (Frisco), whose attorney was not available for conference. On March 15, 2017, Frisco requested an extension, until March 21, 2017, to file a proposed schedule.

The motion to set the hearing on September 26-27, 2017, is denied. One of the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) has another hearing schedule for that week and the next.

Frisco's motion for an extension is granted. The parties shall confer and propose a schedule by **March 21, 2017**. The ALJs are not available on the following dates: September 8, 18-19, 22, and 25-29 or October 2-9, 2017. Until March 21, 2017, the ALJs will hold open the remaining dates in September and October. Should the parties not be able to agree to a hearing on the remaining dates in September and October, they should request a prehearing teleconference to set a schedule. Such request should be filed no later than March 21, 2017, and include three agreed settings.
