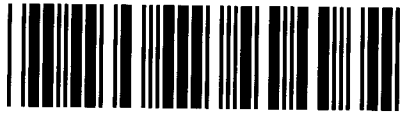

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT;
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the completeness of City of Princeton's application for an amendment to its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity. Commission Staff recommended that the application be found administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies as specifically described in Commission Staff's filing and attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia, Fred Bednarski, and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff proposed that Princeton be given an opportunity to address the deficiencies.

Accordingly, Princeton's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; therefore, at this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **July 1, 2016**, Princeton shall amend its application to cure all indicated deficiencies. The application cannot be further processed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before **August 5, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness and propose a procedural schedule.
