**ORDER NO. 4
 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
 ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On September 1, 2016, the Town of Providence Village filed affidavits of notice, along with a copy of the notices sent, and an affidavit verifying publication of notice. According to the affidavits, notice was mailed to neighboring systems, landowners and cities on August 4, 2016, and published in *Denton Record-Chronicle* on August 8 and August 15, 2016. On September 22, 2016, Public Utility Commission of Texas Staff filed a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and a proposed procedural schedule.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the notice provided by Providence Village is sufficient. Additionally, Commission Staff's procedural schedule is adopted as proposed:
