ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE, REQUESTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND ADDRESSING OTHER PROCEDURAL MATTERS

I. Application

On May 24, 2016, Mustang Special Utility District (Mustang SUD) filed an application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 20930 in Denton County. Mustang SUD seeks to decertify a portion of the City of Oak Point's CCN. The City of Oak Point no longer desires to provide sewer service to the area. Mustang SUD intends to cover the area previously served by the City of Oak Point and to provide service in such areas and in other previous uncertified areas. Some of the area which was previously within the City of Oak Point's sewer CCN and which will be incorporated into Mustang SUD's sewer CCN is within the corporate limits of the Town of Little Elm. The Town Manager of Little Elm, Mr. Matt Mueller, has consented to the proposed amendment.

II. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness of Application and Proposed Notice

On or before **June 23, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice.¹ By **June 23, 2016**, the Company and Commission Staff shall file comments/recommendation regarding how this petition should be processed and propose a procedural schedule. Notice of this application will appear in the June 10, 2016, issue of the *Texas Register*.
