Notice is given to the public of an application filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to amend a water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Denton County, Texas.

Docket Style and Number: Application of Mustang Special Utility District to Amend a Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Denton County, Docket Number 45989.

The Application: Mustang Special Utility District (Mustang SUD) filed an application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20930 in Denton County. Mustang SUD seeks to decertify a portion of the City of Oak Point's CCN. The City of Oak Point no longer desires to provide sewer service to the area. Mustang SUD intends to cover the area previously served by the City of Oak Point and to provide service in such areas and in other previous uncertified areas. Some of the area which was previously within the City of Oak Point's sewer CCN and which will be incorporated into Mustang SUD's sewer CCN is within the corporate limits of the Town of Little Elm. The Town Manager of Little Elm, Mr. Matt Mueller, has consented to the proposed amendment.
