

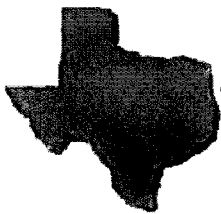

Dear Ms. Clark:

Attached please find proposed tariff pages for the Texas Statewide Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (TSTCI) Intrastate Access Service Tariff. We are requesting administrative approval and a July 1, 2016 effective date for the proposed tariff pages.

These tariff revisions are being made to comply with the FCC's Transformation Order, June 5, 2012 Order, and the March 27, 2013 Order requiring that transitional intrastate switched access rates be moved to parity with interstate switched access rates effective July 2, 2013.

On June 16th, the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) will file increased rate revisions to the NECA Interstate Access Services Tariff. Paragraph 14 of the March 27, 2013 Order requires NECA to adjust its capped rates based on changes in Traffic Sensitive Pool participation. Paragraph 15 of that Order requires pooling carriers to maintain parity rates in their intrastate tariff.

Consequently, based on the above referenced FCC Orders and the requirement to maintain parity with the interstate rate structure and rate levels, we must adjust the rate levels in the TSTCI Intrastate Access Tariff.


Additionally, this filing includes revisions to the intrastate switched access rates for Guadalupe Valley Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (GVTC). GVTC has elected to exit the NECA Interstate Access Services Tariff and will be filing its own Interstate Access Tariff on June 16th. GVTC's enclosed intrastate tariff revisions will maintain parity with its interstate switched access rates as required per the FCC Orders referenced above.

Finally, this filing modifies tariff pages to remove all references and rate sheets for Southwest Texas Telephone Company. Several months ago, Southwest Texas Telephone Company filed its own Intrastate Access Service Tariff and removed itself as an Issuing Carrier of the TSTCI Intrastate Access Service Tariff.

We have enclosed an extra copy of the tariff filing and respectfully request that the stamped-approved tariff pages be returned to us for our duty in maintaining an accurate copy of the tariff as approved.
