COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Supplemental Recommendation.

BACKGROUND . I.

On May 31, 2016, Crystal Springs Water Company, Inc. (Crystal Springs) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11373 and sewer CCN No. 20782 in Montgomery County. Texas. Subsequently, Crystal Springs notified Staff that the application incorrectly stated the sewer CCN number and that the correct number was 20906.

On January 20, 2017, the administrative law judge issued Order No. 5, which set March 14, 2017 as the deadline for Crystal Springs to file proof of TCEQ approval of its water distribution plans. The ALJ also ordered Staff to review Crystal Springs' proof of TCEQ plans within 10 days of Crystal Springs filing proof of TCEQ approval of its plans. Following Crystal Springs' request for extension, the administrative law judge set May 1, 2017 as the deadline for Crystal Springs to file proof of TCEQ approve of its water distribution system in Order No. 6, filed on April 13, 2017. That order also stated that the remainder of the procedural schedule in Order No. 5 applied. Crystal Springs filed proof of TCEQ approval of its plans on May 8, 2017.

II. STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed Crystal Springs' proof of TCEQ plans and has determined that it is sufficient for further processing of this docket. Staff will submit a final recommendation pursuant to the procedural schedule in Order No. 5.
