**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, GRANTING ABATEMENT AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES**


This Order addresses Commission Staff June 30, 2016 recommendations in this application. As more specifically discussed in Commission Staff's pleading and the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Commission Staff recommends that Crystal Springs Water Company, Inc.'s application be deemed administratively complete and that Crystal Springs be required to provide notice of the application to all affected parties consistent with the instructions and using the forms provided. However, Commission Staff also stated that processing of this docket is dependent on Crystal Springs receiving approval for its plans from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), which approval has not yet been received. Therefore, Commission Staff recommended abatement of this application for up to 60 days, awaiting TCEQ approval, and if such approval is not received by August 29, 2016, stated that Commission Staff will move for dismissal, without prejudice.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is deemed administratively complete and Crystal Springs shall provide notice of the application to all affected parties consistent with the instructions and using the forms provided by Commission Staff on June 30, 2016. Additionally, this proceeding is abated for up to 60 days. On or before **August 29, 2016** Crystal Springs may submit proof that TCEQ approved the utility's plan. Within ten days of Crystal Springs submission of proof, but no later than **September 13, 2016**, Commission Staff shall comment on the sufficiency of any filing made by Crystal Springs, propose additional procedural schedule, as appropriate, and make other motions, as appropriate.
