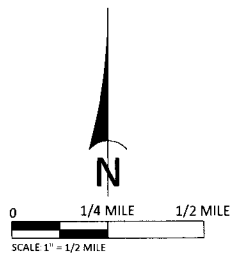


PROPOSED TRACT TO BE

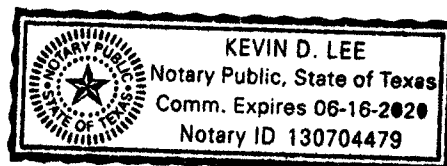
