

Please be advised that the Copeville SUD water certificate attached to the PUC Interoffice Memorandum filed in this docket on August 5, 2019 shows CCN No. 10066 in place of the correct CCN No. 11376. A copy of the memorandum and certificate is attached for your convenience as Attachment A. Please issue a new certificate to Copeville SUD showing CCN No. 11376.

Attachment B, hereto, is an example of a filing in a docket with a similar situation. We are requesting the same be filed in this docket as soon as possible.

Copeville SUD recently executed two service contracts to provide water and sewer service to approximately 2,500 residential lots with thousands more on the way. Subject: *Project No. 46033, Copeville Water Supply Corporation (WSC) to convert to Copeville Special Utility District (SUD); CCN No. 11376 in Collin County, Texas; (TCEQ Application No. 36505-C)*

On September 23, 2009, Copeville WSC (Applicant) filed an application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to convert from a WSC to a SUD in Collin County, pursuant to the criteria in the Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC), Chapter 13, and the TCEQ's rules outlined in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§293.11 and 293.12. The TCEQ approved an order on February 6, 2007, allowing for the conversion of the Copeville WSC to Copeville SUD. A successful confirmation election of Copeville SUD was held on May 15, 2007. With this election, Copeville WSC is now Copeville SUD.

As part of the conversion process, Copeville SUD was required to file for dissolution of Copeville WSC. Staff confirmed a "Certificate of Dissolution" was issued to Copeville WSC by the Office of Secretary of State on March 31, 2008. The dissolution of Copeville WSC allows for the transfer of the corporation's assets and liabilities to the SUD, therefore dissolving the corporation.

Since evidence of a successful confirmation election and dissolution of Copeville WSC has been provided to the Public Utility Commission, water CCN No. 11376 may now be issued in the name of Copeville SUD. A certificate regarding the transfer and conversion is attached. The Commission's records and maps been updated to reflect the new information.


