## COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest and files this Request to Amend Procedural Schedule, and would show the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On June 9, 2016, Mark Groba filed a petition with the Commission appealing the decision of Noack Water Supply Corporation (Noack WSC) for the cost of obtaining service. On July 12, 2016, Order No. 2 was issued, finding the petition administratively complete and requiring Staff issue its final recommendation on the petition by October 11, 2016 and for the parties to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation and/or to request a hearing by October 25, 2016. Staff timely filed its recommendation on October 11, 2016.

### II. REQUEST TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Commission Staff has been in discussion with the parties in an attempt to resolve the issues raised in Mr. Groba's petition. However, this attempt has not been successful. Mr. Groba wishes to respond to Staff's recommendation but requires additional time for his response. Accordingly, Staff requests the following amendment to the procedural schedule:
