**INTERCITY SERVICES**

**I. INTRASTATE CARRIER COMMON LINE AND SWITCHED ACCESS SERVICES**

For switched access services provided in the following ILEC's serving area, the Company adopts the rates, terms, and conditions of ILEC's switched access rates, except for Carrier Common Line, Local Switching, and Local Transport rates. \*Terminating switched access rates are in compliance with the FCC 11-161 CAF Order and 47 C.F.R. § 61.26(e); the Company is a Rural CLEC as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 61.26(a)(6) and benchmarked to the switched access rates in NECA Tariff No. 5. Pursuant to DA-13-564, Order, Rel. March 27, 2013, WC Docket No. 10-90, pg. 9, ¶ 16, the FCC "clarifies that, if a switched access rate is revised as a result of the NECA pool entry and exit process, any competitive local exchange carrier (CLEC) benchmarking to that rate must benchmark to the revised rate."

\*\*NECA does not have a shared or common trunk port rate element in its rate structure.
