

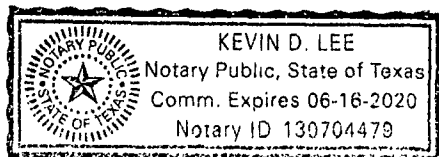

Notice for Publication

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) TO PROVIDE WATER AND SEWER SERVICE IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS

Quadvest, L.P. filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to Amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity Nos. 11612 and 20952 to provide water and sewer service in Montgomery County.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 5 miles east/northeast of downtown **Magnolia, Texas**, and is generally located on the north by **.6 mile south of Lake Creek**; on the east by **Gable Circle**; on the south by **FM 1488**; and on the west by **.8 mile east of FM 149**.

The total area being requested includes approximately 202 acres and 0 current customers.

A copy of the proposed service area map is available at: 26926 FM 2978, Magnolia, Texas 77354.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing" (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Within thirty (30) days from the date of this application or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All requests to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a meets and bounds description of the tract of land.

Persons who meet the requirements to opt out, and wish to request this option should file required documents with the:
