ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS

SOAH ORDER NO. 1 DESCRIPTION OF CASE, NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE, AND GENERAL PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS

I. DESCRIPTION OF CASE

On June 16, 2016, Nitsch & Son Utility Company, Inc. (Nitsch) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for a Class B rate/tariff change for water service under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11124 and sewer service under CCN No. 20446 (the Application).

Commission Order No. 2 (issued by a Commission Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) on July 19, 2016) found the Application sufficient and suspended the rate change effective date for 265 days from Nitsch's proposed effective date of July 27, 2016, until April 18, 2017, or the issuance of a final order, whichever occurs first.

On November 30, 2016, as recommended by Staff, in its Order of Referral the Commission referred this case to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH), requesting the assignment of a SOAH ALJ to conduct a hearing and issue, a proposal for decision, if such is necessary. The Order of Referral states that Staff has requested a hearing in the case and that it appears that over 10 % of affected ratepayers have filed a petition to appeal the rates. The order also states that the Commission will consider and possibly adopt at an open meeting currently scheduled for January 12, 2016, a preliminary order that includes a list of issues in this case and any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on threshold issues.

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The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Code §§ 13.041, 13.042,

13.1872(c)(2), and 13.1871 and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.22. SOAH has jurisdiction

over matters in this case relating to the conduct of the hearing and issuance of a proposal for

decision, if needed, pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2003.049.

II. NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE
