
Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the notice and affidavits are deemed sufficient. The following procedural schedule shall apply:

Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation	December 23, 2016
Expiration of 120-day deadline from date of notice for Commission action	February 3, 2017
