**ORDER NO. 5

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice of the application filed by Quadvest and establishes a procedural schedule for continued processing. On September 19, 2016, Quadvest filed proof of notice. An additional supplement was filed on October 4, 2016.


The notice provided by Quadvest is deemed sufficient. Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Event	Date
Notice completed	August 17, 2016
Deadline for intervention	September 16, 2016 ¹
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Quadvest for review and consent	November 30, 2016
Deadline for Quadvest to file signed consent forms with the Commission	December 13, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	December 20, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	January 5, 2017

¹ Under 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.106(a)(3), the intervention deadline is 30 days after the mailing or last publication of notice, whichever occurs later. The last date of notice was August 17, 2016.
