**ORDER NO. 10
 REQUESTING CLARIFICATION;
 ESTABLISHING DEADLINES**

This Order requests clarification from Commission Staff and Cape Shores Land LLC. The record does not appear to include a CCN certificate for Tri-County Point Property Owners Association. Tri-County did file its consent to the map and certificate but the record does not include the documents. Also, the Amended Proposed Notice of Approval states in Finding of Fact No. 23 that the Commission received no protests, motions to intervene, or requests for hearing.

Cape Shores LLC requested the Commission deny the application in a January 12, 2017 filing and in a subsequent filing on January 31, 2017. Cape Shores indicated in the January 31, 2017 filing that further information was being provided but it appears that such information was omitted in the filing. On or before April 4, 2017, Cape Shores shall file any information that may have inadvertently been omitted from its January 31, 2017 filing.

On or before April 18, 2017, Commission Staff is requested to provide the map and CCN certificate for Tri-County and also comment on Cape Shores' filing and whether this proceeding remains appropriate for informal disposition.
