## ORDER NO. 3 DEEMING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND COMPLETE; ESTABLISHING DEADLINES FOR REMAINDER OF PROCEEDING

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 9, 2016 recommendation on notice and an updated procedural schedule in this application. Commission Staff stated that on August 25, 2016, Bethany Hearne Water Supply Company and the City of Hearne filed an affidavit of notice evidencing that notice of this proceeding was provided on August 16, 2016 to current customers, neighboring systems, and cities. Therefore, the 120-day deadline to approve the sale administratively or require a public hearing<sup>1</sup> ends on December 14, 2016. Commission Staff proposed a supplemental procedural schedule for the remainder of this proceeding based on that deadline.

The following procedural schedule is adopted, as proposed:

Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation	October 28, 2016
