**ORDER NO. 7
APPROVING SALE AND TRANSFER TRANSACTION TO PROCEED**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 21, 2017 recommendation that the transaction between La Playa Subdivision Water System and Simply Aquatics, Inc. should be allowed to proceed. The La Playa Subdivision is a part of Sam Rayburn Water, Inc. which holds certificate of convenience and necessity No. 11707.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the transaction proposed in this application may proceed and be consummated. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after, applicants shall file proof that the transaction has been consummated.¹ Commission Staff noted that there are no deposits held by Sam Rayburn Water for the customers being served by the La Playa Subdivision Water System.

Applicants have 180 days to complete the transaction.² If the transaction is not consummated within this period, or an extension requested and granted, this approval to proceed is void.³ Applicants are advised that the portion of CCN No. 11707 covering La Playa Subdivision will continue to be held by Sam Rayburn Water, Inc. until the sale and transfer transaction is complete in accordance with the Commission's rules.

Beginning **June 2, 2017**, and continuing monthly thereafter, applicants shall file monthly updates regarding the status of the efforts to complete sale/transfer transaction.



Within 15 days following the filing of applicants' proof that the transaction has been consummated and customer deposits (if any) have been addressed, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for the continued processing of this docket.
