**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation that Las Playa Subdivision Water System's and Simply Aquatics, Inc.'s application is deficient. Commission Staff recommended that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's August 15, 2016 pleading and the attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia and Tracy Montes in the Commission's Water Utilities Regulation Division.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **September 15, 2016**, applicants shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **October 17, 2016** Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if appropriate.
