## COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 6 and Supplemental Recommendation Finding Application Administratively Complete. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

#### I. Background

On July 14, 2016, El Pinon Water Supply (El Pinon) and Simply Aquatics, Inc. (Simply Aquatics) (collectively the Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in San Augustine County. Specifically, Simply Aquatics seeks approval to acquire all of the water system assets of El Pinon held under water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 12206, and the certificate itself. The total area being requested includes approximately 69 acres and serves 76 current customers.

On March 15, 2017, Order No. 6 was issued finding the application administratively incomplete and deficient and requiring the Applicants to amend the application to cure the deficiencies identified by Staff by March 28, 2017. On April 12, 2017, the Applicants filed supplemental application materials, curing the deficiencies identified by Staff. Order No. 6 also required Staff to file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the amended application and propose additional deadline as appropriate with 10 working days of the Applicants' filing. Accordingly, this pleading is timely filed.

#### II. Recommendation on Administrative Sufficiency

Staff has reviewed the application and notice in accordance with Tex. Water Code Ann. § 13.301 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.8, 24.109 and 24.112 (TAC) and, as supported by the attached memorandum from Patricia Garcia, Engineer and Tracy Montes, GIS Specialist with

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the Water Utilities Division, Staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete and accepted for filing pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.8(a). In addition, Staff recommends the following:

- 1. The Applicants provide notice to the following:
  - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed area;
  - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
  - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified:
  - d) any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the proposed area.
- 2. The Applicants provide notice to the following entities:
  - a) El Pinon Water Supply (CCN No. 12206)
  - b) Angelina & Neches River Authority
  - c) Deep East Texas Groundwater Conservation District
  - d) San Augustine County Judge

Within 30 days of the Commission order, Staff recommends that the Applicants be required to file a copy of the actual notices issued, the map issued with the individual mailed notices, and the signed affidavits (copies attached), indicating that the notices were given.

#### III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Event	Deadline
Deadline for Applicants to file affidavits of proof of notice.	June 13, 2017
Deadline for Staff to file comments on proof of notice.	Within 10 working days of Applicants filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline for intervention; deadline for intervenors to request a hearing on the merits	30 days after notice is issued

#### IV. Conclusion

Staff respectfully requests that an order be issued consistent with this Recommendation.

On July 14, 2016, Simply Aquatics, Inc. (Simply Aquatics or Purchaser) and El Pinon Water Supply (El Pinon or Seller), (Collectively Applicants), filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in San Augustine County, Texas pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. § 13:301 (TWC) and the 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.109 and 24.112 (TAC). Specifically, Simply Aquatics seeks approval to acquire facilities, customers and service area under El Pinon's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12206. If approved, Simply Aquatics will be issued a water CCN and CCN No. 12206 will be cancelled.

In response to Order No. 6, the Applicants filed requested information on April 12, 2017. Staff has reviewed the information and recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and administratively complete. Staff further recommends the following:

- 1. The Applicants provide notice to the following:
  - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed area;
  - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
  - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
  - d) any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the proposed area.
- 2. The Applicants provide notice to the following entities:
  - a) El Pinon Water Supply (CCN No. 12206)
  - b) Angelina & Neches River Authority
  - c) Deep East Texas Groundwater Conservation District
  - d) San Augustine County Judge

Within 30 days of the Commission order, Staff recommends that the Applicants be required to file a copy of the actual notice sent and notarized affidavit attesting that the notice was given.

If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
