COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 4 and Supplemental Recommendation Finding Application Administratively Complete. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. Background

On July 14, 2016, Vista Verde Water Systems, Inc. (Vista Verde) and Simply Aquatics, Inc. (Simply Aquatics) (collectively the Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Montgomery County. Specifically, Simply Aquatics seeks approval to acquire all of the water system assets of Vista Verde held under water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13034, and the certificate itself. The total area being requested includes approximately 346 acres and serves 45 current customers.

On November 21, 2016, Order No. 4 was issued requiring the Applicants to amend the application to cure the deficiencies identified by Staff by December 30, 2016. On December 12 and 29, 2016 the Applicants filed supplemental application materials, including updated mapping content. Order No. 4 also required Staff to file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the amended application and propose additional deadline as appropriate by January 27, 2017. Accordingly, this pleading is timely filed.

II. Recommendation on Administrative Sufficiency

Staff has reviewed the application and notice in accordance with Tex. Water Code Ann. § 13.301 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.8, 24.109 and 24.112 (TAC) and, as supported by the attached memorandum from Patricia Garcia, Engineer and Tracy Montes, GIS Specialist with

the Water Utilities Division, Staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete and accepted for filing pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.8(a). In addition, Staff recommends the following:

- 1. The Applicants shall provide notice to the following:
 - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed area;
 - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
 - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
 - d) any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the requested area.
- 2. The Applicants shall provide notice to the following entities: Aqua Texas Inc. (CCN No. 13203) City of Conroe Conroe Resort Utilities LLC (CCN NO. 11942) Del Lago Estates Water Supply Corporation (WSC) (CCN No. 12103) Keenan WSC (CCN No. 11409) Lake Bonanza WSC (CCN No. 12703) Lake Lorraine Civic Organization (CCN No. 11357) MSEC Enterprises Inc. (CCN No. 12887) Pine Lake WSC Inc. (CCN No. 12941) Quadvest LP (CCN No. 11612) Saddle & Surrey Acres WSC (CCN No. 12774) Stanley Lake Municipal Utility District (MUD) (CCN No. 11222) T & W Water Service (CCN No. 12892) Vista Verde Water Systems, Inc. (CCN No. 13034) Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District (GCD) Martin Creek MUD Montgomery County MUD 8 Montgomery County MUD 9 Montgomery County Utility District 3 Montgomery County Utility District 4 San Jacinto River Authority Stanley Lake MUD Montgomery County Judge

Within 30 days of the Commission order, Staff recommends that the Applicants be required to file a copy of the actual notices issued, the map issued with the individual mailed notices, and the signed affidavits (copies attached), indicating that the notices were given.

On July 14, 2016, Simply Aquatics, Inc., (Simply Aquatics or Purchaser) and Vista Verde Water Systems, Inc. (Vista Verde or Seller), (collectively Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Montgomery County, Texas pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. § 13.301 (TWC) and the 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.109 and 24.112 (TAC). Specifically, Simply Aquatics seeks approval to acquire all of the water system assets, customers and service area under Vista Verde's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13034. If approved, Simply Aquatics will be issued a water CCN to serve the area formerly covered by CCN No. 13034 and CCN No. 13034 will be cancelled.

Order No. 4 established deadlines for Staff to respond to the application by January 27, 2017. Based upon a review of the application, Staff recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and administratively complete. Staff further recommends the following:

- 1. The Applicants provide notice to the following:
 - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed area;
 - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
 - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
 - d) any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the requested area.
- 2. The Applicants provide notice to the following entities: Aqua Texas Inc. (CCN No. 13203)

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Within 30 days of the Commission order, Staff recommends that the Applicants be required to file a copy of the actual notice sent and notarized affidavit attesting that the notice was given.

A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. If a public hearing is requested, Commission will not transfer the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
