ORDER NO. 2 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's August 17 2016 recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application of Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua Texas) to amend its certificates of convenience and necessity in Chambers County and Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively complete and that Aqua Texas be required to provide notice as instructed and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. Aqua Texas shall provide notice consistent with Commission Staff's August 17 2016 recommendation and as specified in the attached memorandum of Andrew Novak and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to Commission Staff's memorandum.

Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application and represented that Aqua Texas agrees with the proposed schedule. The following procedural schedule shall apply:

Deadline for Aqua Texas to file signed affidavits that notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	October 3, 2016.
