



Aqua Texas, Inc. filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend their CCN No. 13203 and 21065 for the provision of water and sewer service in Chambers County, Texas.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 4 miles southeast of downtown Mont Belvieu, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by 0.76 mile south of IH 10; on the east by 1 mile west of EM 3246; on the south by EM 365; and on the west by Cotton Bayou.

The total area for the sewer CCN being requested includes approximately 93.49 acres and 0 current customers.

A copy of the proposed service area map is available at: 2211 Aneta Spring Road, Spring, Texas 77388.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement of why you request a public hearing; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Persons who wish to intervene or comment should file their request with the Commission

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All request to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a metes and bounds description of the tract of land.
