**ORDER NO. 2  
DEEMING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT; ADDRESSING NOTICE AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on the sufficiency of the application filed by SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Diamond Water Company (Diamond Water) and SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Water Services, Inc. (Water Services) (collectively, Applicants) for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Bandera, Comal and Gillespie Counties.

**I. Administrative Completeness**

On August 19, 2016, Commission Staff recommended the application be found sufficient and complete. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively complete.

**II. Notice**

Commission Staff also recommended that Applicants provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued. Consistent with Staff's recommendation, Applicants shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's August 19, 2016 filing and consistent with the criteria outlined in the attached memorandum of Emily Sears and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. Applicants shall file an affidavit evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

**III. Procedural Schedule**

Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket. Accordingly, the following procedural schedule shall apply:

Deadline for Applicants to file proof of notice with the Commission	September 21, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice provided	Within 14 days of Applicants filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
